RECYCLING SAFARI





Did you know your used plastic bottle could become a material bag? Or your dad's old car tyre could become your pencil case? Or your food waste could become your garden compost?

Rhys Cycle is about to take you on a journey of waste discovery as you board the safari minibus and venture to the land of Bryn Pica.

During this special visit there will be lots of secrets to uncover as you witness first hand how your waste can be used to create some amazing new items and learn all about how you can become a recycling champion by reducing what you throw away.

Visitor Centre

First stop will see you visit the hub of activity at the visitor centre, where you will find out just how important it is to think clean and green and recycle your waste. You will also get to sneak-a-peek behind the scenes and see what happens to your recycling bags when they arrive at Bryn Pica.

You can learn all about recycling glass, batteries and cans, as well as viewing a video created by Rhys Cycle's green friends at Tonyrefail Comprehensive School, called "Oceans of Waste".

Recently, 1,500 recycled plastic bottles have been re-used at Amgen-Cymru to make a green house - don't forget to ask about this on your journey.



Mini-MRF

Next Stop is down to the Mini-Material Recovery Facility (where all your recycled waste is separated on one big rolling line). Here you will be able to muck in and find out how to sort your waste. It is very important that everybody recycles and knows where, what and how to do this properly!

Landfill Safari

It's now time for you to journey deep into the unknown, where you will discover what could happen if you don't recycle and why Rhys Cycle fights against landfill. As you visit the landfill site you will see how and where your non-recycled waste is kept and how Rhys Cycle uses some of the gasses generated by waste to power your X-Box or TVs at home.
